Visits to the Greenhouses of Four POS Members

This past month I took my camera on visits to the greenhouses of Terry Thompson, Charles and Susan Wilson, Clayton Moore and Judy Barrick, all respected growers who have received many American Orchid Society flower quality and culture awards. Their greenhouses are of a variety of styles and technical sophistication; two were completed in 2015 and two were built in the last millenium. And the orchids grown inside varied from greenhouse to greenhouse.

At each site I took pictures to illustrate our discussions about how and why these growers control their orchids' environments. We covered a range of culturally-significant topics including heating/cooling, humidity control, ventillation, and feeding. At the meeting each of these growers will use these pictures to introduce you to their greenhouse and to discuss the "hows and whys" for their set-ups. This is a unique opportunity to learn about growing orchids in Northwest Oregon.

It was a very nice Sander's Pride and was very well grown.

In April there were 11 judges present and a couple of visitors as well as our photographer, Ross Leach. There were 3 awards presented. They were Masdevallia caudate "Cosmos" CCM/AOS owned by Terry Thompson, Eulophia guineensis HCC/AOS owned by Charles and Susan Wilson and an orchid that used to have an HCC that was upgraded to an AM, Masdevallia ignea "Red Velvet" AM/AOS owned by David Morris. There were also other plants at judging that were very impressive and the judges hope to see them back on their next blooming.




